**CBSE EAST AND FAR EAST ZONE
BADMINTON TOURNAMENT
(02nd OCTOBER 2018 TO 06TH OCTOBER 2018)**

1. CBSE Inter-school Badminton Tournament will be conducted according to the rules of Badminton Association of India(BAI).
2. Every school can send one team comprising of maximum four players, in Under 14, Under 17 and under 19 years separately in Boys” and Girls”category.
3. All the participants must carry their valid age proof certificate and school/CBSE Board Identity-card.
4. All the matches must be played on indoor courts with proper lighting arrangements.
5. In Team Championship, the order of play shall be: Singles-Double-Singles.
6. All the matches that are played on “league basis” - shall be best of one game of 31 points with change of side at 15 points. The player that reaches first at 31 points wins the match.
7. All the matches that are played on “knock-out basis” - shall be of best of three games of 15 points each, & a match is won with the difference of 02 points. In case, of 14 – all; the game shall continue; however, the player that reaches first at 19 points wins the match.
8. At **Zone Level** all the matches will be played strictly on **knock-out basis**. In case the numbers of teams in a particular age category are less, the championship in that category may be organized on league cum knock out basis.
9. From each Zone first position winning team (i.e. winner) will qualify to participate in the National Championship.
10. No change shall be permitted in the composition of team from Zonal Level to National Level.
11. The school organizing Zone Level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate in National Level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of completion along with the original **Entry Form**.
12. National Championship will be conducted on League cum knock-out basis for which all the teams will be divided into different pools.
13. At National level, one day of the Championship shall be dedicated exclusively to the Individual Championship.
14. At National Level: All the teams reporting may be divided into different pools in such a way that by and large no pool is of less than four teams. From each pool, the two teams emerging on top will qualify to play the knock-out stage match.
15. The decision of the Technical Committee/Referee shall be final.
16. Any photograph/video clipping other than from official camera shall not be considered for any reference.
17. No protest will be entertained from parents.
18. Protest, if any, has to submit in writing by the Team Coach/Manager with the Chief Referee, within 15 minutes of the announcement of result. The decision of the Jury of Appeal shall be final.
19. The team players reporting on **1st October 2018** will only be allowed to participate in the Championship. Please send your team(s) accordingly.

20. The Host School will not be responsible for any miss happening during Championship or during journey.
21. All the competitors will bring their personal kit.
22. All the participating teams will be provided lodging facilities. (Adequate and safe hostel and classrooms with clean bath and toilet)
23. Mattress and sheets will be provided for the teams staying.
24. All the participating teams will be provided free transport facility at the time of arrival and departure between Railway Station/Bus stand.
25. The teams making their own stay arrangement will not be provided with mess and transport facility.
26. Accommodation will not be provided to the parents accompanying the participants.
27. The boarding charges shall be Rs. 350/- per head per day including bedding charges. It is advised that from the health and safety point of view, all participating teams dine in the mess arranged by the Organizing school.
28. The participating schools will deposit payments against meals on full day basis and no part payment will be accepted and the participating schools will not insist for refund of part payment.

PARTICIPATING SCHOOL

1. Every affiliated school shall be entitled to enter its athlete/team in the CBSE Sports and Games Competitions. As soon as Calendar is uploaded on the Board's website, the schools may fill-in the online discipline-wise. Entry proformae. No school will be permitted to participate unless they fill the online discipline-wise Entry proformae and by-hand Entry proformae would not be accepted.
2. No team will be permitted to play unless accompanied by a teacher/coach at the venue.
3. In no circumstance the composition of team shall change from, Cluster/Zone to National. In extra ordinary circumstance the changes may be permitted, but only with prior permission from, the CBSE, in writing.
4. All expenses on items like travel, food, kit etc will have to be borne by the participating school.
5. Dining in the mess arranged by the host school is mandatory for the teams that opt to stay in the school provided accommodation.
6. Every player/athlete/team shall carry with them required documents as mentioned under title "Eligibility".
7. Every team will carry their school flag, for the purpose of March Past and to be used during the various ceremonies. Participation in March past is compulsory, failing which their right to participate can be forfeited.
8. It is not obligatory on the part of Organizing school to provide food and transport facility to school/teams making their own stay arrangements. Also, it is the responsibility of the school/teams staying outside, to collect information in regard to matches/fixtures/program etc.

9. Any non-designated person accompanying the team will not be entertained for any matter at the venue and will not be permitted to stay in the premises.
10. In case the player/team is being accompanied only by the parent, it should be informed by the Principal of participating school in writing.

ACCREDITED REPRESENTATIVES (TEACHER/COACH/MANAGER)

1. All the teams shall be accompanied by Teacher/Coach/Manager designated by the participating school principal.
2. No team will be permitted to participate without accompanying official.
3. No team shall be accompanied by any parent. However if a parent is accompanying the team, such information may be provided by the school on the school letterhead.
4. No team shall be accompanied by more than two officials.
5. In case of Girls participants, one of the accompanying officials must be a female.
6. The officials accompanying the team shall have a valid Identity Card issued by their school Principal.
7. No extra person shall be permitted to stay inside the school premises and on the playfield along with the teams.

ENTRIES

1. As soon as the sports calendar has been uploaded, it becomes the responsibility of the schools to fill in the entry proforma online.
2. Each school shall be entitled to enter only one team or individual for each tournament/meet/event.
3. For the year in which Cluster/Zone/National level Championship is not completed in a particular discipline, the members of the participating schools, in that discipline for that year will not be considered for the purpose of award of Championship.
4. A junior player can be permitted to play in senior group, and then the participation in the original group will be forfeited.
5. Soon after filling-in the entry proforma, schools shall make travel booking and send the information to the Organizing school for making the necessary arrangements.
6. Whatsoever the reason may be, one the spot entry and late entry will not be entertained.

WITHDRAWING SCHOOL

1. If a school, after filling-in its entry, wished to withdraw from a tournament/meet, it shall give a written request of its intention to do so to the **Organizing Secretary/School**.
2. School withdrawing without informing/requesting the Organizing school, will be penalized with a penalty of Rs.1000.

IMPORTANT: IT SHALL BE MANDATORY FOR ALL THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING ON ARRIVAL AT VENUE.

- (i) The documents for verification to original if asked for.
- (ii) The team photo with school Principal along with the Entry Proforma, countersigned by the concerned Principal.
- (iii) To provide CBSE registration number for student/player studying in class IX and above.
- (iv) To supply the eligibility Proforma filed-in online, countersigned by the concerned Principal.
- (v) The eligibility entry Proforma shall be according to age group under 14/under 17/under 19.

ELIGIBILITY

Age:

The athlete/player should be within the particular age group on 31 December of the year of competition.

- (i) Only bonafide students shall be eligible to participate in the Inter-School tournaments/meets. Feeding any non bonafide student shall lead to disqualification of the team.
- (ii) A student, who has failed twice in a particular class, shall no more be eligible to participate. Incomplete information in any respect is liable for disqualification of team.
- (iii) Any violation in eligibility (over age impersonation) shall be dealt according to rules.
- (iv) The original eligibility Proforma of the athletes/players/teams qualifying to participate from Cluster/Zone level to National level will have to be certified by the Organizing school at Cluster/Zone level as the case may be and forwarded to the National Organizing School, immediately after their Cluster/Zone level competition is over.
- (v) Medical checkup may also be applied by the Jury of Appeal appointed by organizing school in the cases of overage suspicion.
- (vi) A player shall be under 11, under 14, under 17 and under 19 years of age on **31st December 2018**.
 - 1. Under 11 years: Born on or after 01.01.2008
 - 2. Under 14 years: Born on or after 01.01.2005
 - 3. Under 17 years: Born on or after 01.01.2002
 - 4. Under 19 years: Born on or after 01.01.2000
- (vii) All the supporting papers verifying the age of the player, etc in original, as per the CBSE Guidelines and Rules shall be carried personally by the Team Manager/Coach while reporting for participation.
- (viii) The player's right to participate forfeits if fails to produce the papers supporting the eligibility in original on demand.

Any team/athlete not fulfilling the eligibility criteria before the commencement of the tournament/meet shall not be permitted to participate.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

A player/team may be disqualified/scratched for the following reasons.

1. If the ineligibility of any member of the team is detected.
2. Inclusion of non bonafide student in the team.
3. Misbehavior on ground by athlete or accompanying official.
4. Use of abusive language by athlete or accompanying official.
5. Misbehavior with officials/opponents by athlete or accompanying official.
6. Indiscipline at the place of stay by athlete or accompanying official.
7. Damaging the school property.
8. Indiscipline during the opening and closing ceremonies by athlete or accompanying officials.
9. Non participation in March Past.

The organizing school in no case shall show the eligibility Proforma or any other paper of a team to anyone who lodges the protest. It is only jury of appeal's prerogative to verify all the documents.

The organizing school shall submit details of the defaulters to the Jt. Director (Sports) reporting the names of the schools/athletes in a separate cover. All such defaulters will be debarred from the participation in CBSE Inter School Sports and Games Competition for the next year. If any of such schools resorts to unfair means again, in the subsequent years, it will be debarred for three years.

PROTEST

Protest of any nature in connection with the tournament shall be in writing and must reach the Organizing Secretary and CBSE Observer within one hour of the declaration of the result, duly accompanied by a fee of Rs. 1000/- .

Such a protest will be considered by Jury of Appeal, consisting of the following –

1. Principal, Organizing School
2. Organizing Secretary
3. CBSE observer
4. One or Two technically qualified people present at the venue

The parties under dispute may be heard before deciding the issue. In case the protest is upheld, the protest fee shall be refunded to the protesting school otherwise the fee shall be forfeited.

The decision taken by the Jury of Appeal will be final and binding.

The decision, together with full facts of the protest may immediately be reported to the Jt. Director (sports) CBSE.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Team Manager/Coaches shall provide the required documents for verification in original, if asked for by the controller.

- 2) Team photo with school principal along with the entry proforma duly countersigned by the concerned principal shall be produced at the time of entry in the school campus.
- 3) All the competitors shall provide CBSE Registration UID number.
- 4) Identity cards to be brought by the students and coaches duly stamped and signed by the principal.
- 5) Proof of the payment of CBSE Annual Sports fee for the year 2018-19.
- 6) Girl participants should be escorted by Female Escorts (Manager).

BOARDING & LODGING

- Boarding and lodging charges will be Rs.350/- (Three hundred fifty only)- per day per head.
- Boarding and lodging charges will be paid in advance which are refundable depending upon facilities used.
- All the Team manager and players will be accommodated in the school planned separately for Boys and Girls. No accommodation for parents or any other person accompanying.
- No costly or jewellery etc are to be brought to the campus during championships the school will not be responsible for the loss of any personal belongings.


